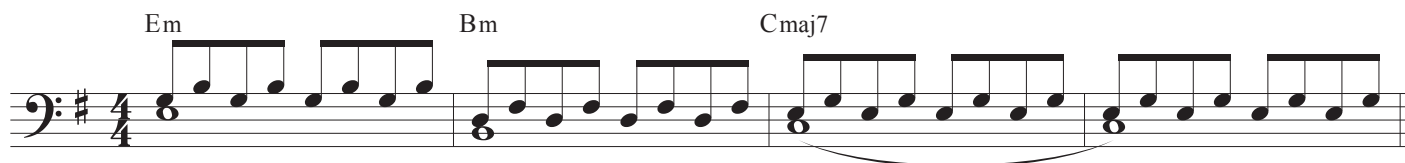


Explore improvising & creating your own song.



How to start improvising and creating music...

Start by listening to Billie Eilish's song, "lovely"

Once you have an idea of how the song sounds, try playing the left hand accompaniment pattern above.

When you can play the 4 bar phrase well, try adding a couple of notes with the RH. Start with A & B as they are used in "lovely". As you feel ready, add more notes from the list above.

Let your ear be the guide, if it doesn't sound good, you're probably only one note away from a note that does sound good.

Play your improvisation for your friends and family.

Try writing your own song...

Once you're confident, try writing some words to go with your song. Billie's song is called "lovely". What's lovely mean for you? For some people it is their pet, or flowers or their grandma.



Write a sentence about what you think is lovely. Then try to write a another sentence that rhymes at the end. If you need some help finding a word that rhymes, check our [rhymezone.com](https://www.rhymezone.com) for help. Keep on exploring to see what you can make up.

Remember there is no right or wrong, just exploring means you're learning heaps of new skills
